

What exactly is Microsoft Learning piloting?

Microsoft Learning is piloting new technologies specific to instructor-led training to benefit CPLSs. The learning content itself is not changing, just the methods of delivering and accessing it. See below for a brief explanation of each component being piloted:

Labs Online: As an alternative to downloading lab images for courses (which must be setup and configured on local computers), Labs Online allows you the ability to access labs online, hosted by Microsoft Learning.

Digital MOC (DMOC): In conjunction with Labs Online, Digital Microsoft Official Curriculum (DMOC) will make its debut. DMOC is the ILT we currently provide in a digital form (PDF) to CPLSs, trainers, and students. It will be made available for purchase through Courseware Library alongside Labs Online.

“Virtual” ILT: Virtual instructor-led training is combining the functionality of DMOC and Labs Online with the power of Microsoft Live Meeting. This combination of platforms and technologies will allow students to receive training on Microsoft products from live instructors without being in a physical classroom.
